Leaver's Service – Thursday 17th July

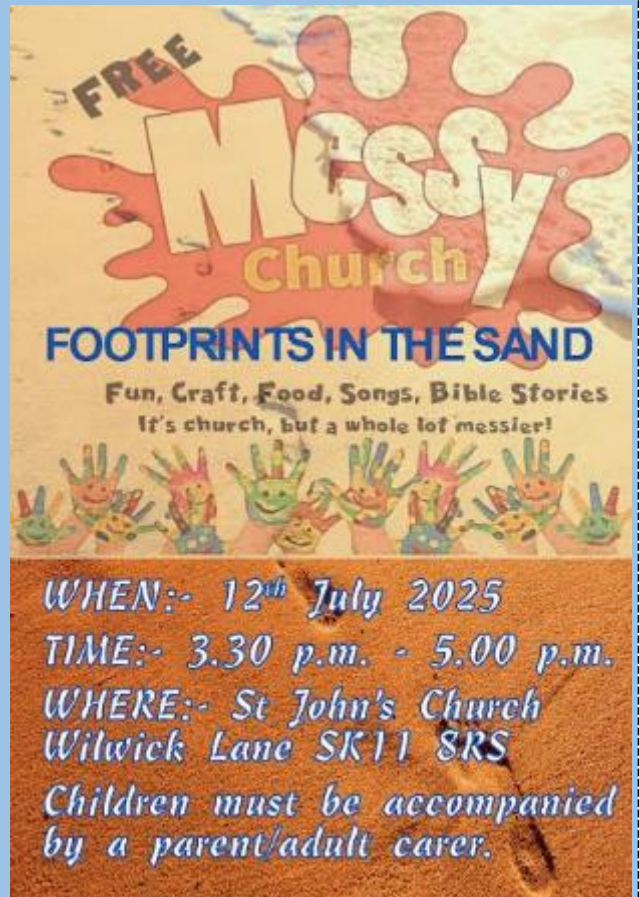

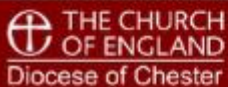

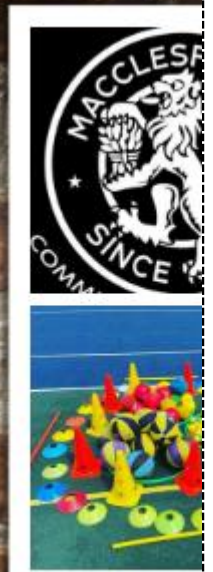
