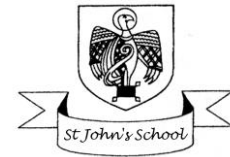

Parent's Consent for Using Images of Children

Occasionally, we may take photographs of the children at our school. We may use these images in our school prospectus or in other printed publications that we produce, as well as on our website, or as part of displays around school. We may also make video or webcam recordings for monitoring or other educational use.

Sometimes our school may be visited by the media who will take photographs or film footage of a visiting dignitary or other high profile event. Pupils will often appear in these images, which may appear in local or national newspapers, online, or on televised news programmes.

Any images or video we use of your child would be published subject to the school rule that photographs will not be accompanied by pupil names.

Before we take a photograph, we need written consent in order to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 and General Data Protection Regulation 2018.
