## Would you like a school uniform voucher for £50?

Each child registered for Free School Meals brings £1,320 per pupil per year to the school for each year that they attend – even if the parents' benefits change during that time. These additional funds are used for extra teaching staff and classroom support and really make a difference to our pupils. Free School Meal related funding is available for infants and juniors, and even if they don't have school meals and would prefer to eat sandwiches.

With this in mind we would request that if you receive any of the following benefits you please claim for income related Free School Meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less that £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Making a claim takes just one phone call and you only have to claim once, please call **Free School Meals Helpline** on **0300 123 5012.** 

Any pupil that has a new Free School Meals claim approved will receive a £50 school uniform voucher to spend at the ClassworX store in Macclesfield.
